

**MUTUAL AGREEMENT TO EXTEND PERIOD FOR MUNICIPAL REVIEW
BETWEEN THE TOWN OF SCHAGHTICOKE
AND STILLWATER RENEWABLES, LLC**


Whereas Stillwater Renewables, LLC (the “Applicant”) submitted an application to construct a 4.5 megawatt photovoltaic solar farm at 36 Stillwater Bridge Road, in the Town of Schaghticoke, New York to the Town of Schaghticoke Planning Board (the “Planning Board”) which requires a special use permit and site plan review on September 24, 2019 (the “Application”). The Town of Schaghticoke Planning Board held a public hearing on the Application on January 8, 2020.

Thereafter, the Town’s engineering consultant submitted comments on the Application in correspondence dated March of 2020. The Applicant and the Planning Board have requested additional time to consider and address the comments from the Town’s engineering consultant. Thereafter, the April 2020 and May 2020 regularly scheduled Planning Board meetings were cancelled due to COVID-19 precautions. The Planning Board is currently determining when to hold meetings in June and July of 2020 due to the COVID-19 Executive Orders and guidance.

The Town of Schaghticoke Zoning Law requires that a decision on the Application be made within 62 days of the public hearing (*see* Zoning Law Section VI(D), VII(D) and VII(F)). However, the Applicant and the Town of Schaghticoke Planning Board mutually agree to extend the review of the Application and time period for the Planning Board to render a decision on the Application through the July 1, 2020 regular Planning Board meeting so that the Applicant and the Planning Board have an opportunity to consider and address issues raised in the March of 2020 correspondence from the Planning Board’s engineering consultant and to accommodate the Planning Board’s unforeseen meeting cancellations.
